<b>Forthwith:</b>	“immediately”
<b>Hereafter:</b>	“after this” in sequence or in time.
<b>Hereby:</b>	“by means of this”
<b>Herein:</b>	“in this”
<b>Hereof:</b>	“of this”
<b>Hereon:</b>	“on this”
<b>Hereto:</b>	“to this document”
<b>Heretofore:</b>	“up to this time”
<b>Hereunder:</b>	“under this” or “according to this writing”
<b>Hereunto:</b>	“to this”
<b>Hereupon:</b>	“on this” or “immediately after this”
<b>Herewith:</b>	“with this”
<b>Thereafter:</b>	“after that” or “afterward”
<b>Thereat:</b>	“at that place” or “at that occurrence” or “on that account”
<b>Thereby:</b>	“by that” or “by that means” or “connected with” or “with reference to that”
<b>Therefor:</b>	“for that” or “in return for that”
<b>Therefore:</b>	“for that reason (consequently)”
<b>Therefrom:</b>	“from that” or “from it”
<b>Therein:</b>	“in” or “into that place, time or thing” or “in that respect”
<b>Thereof:</b>	“of that” or “of it” or “from that”
<b>Thereon:</b>	“on that” (also, thereupon)
<b>Thereo:</b>	“to that (also, thereunto)
<b>Thereupon:</b>	“on that matter” or “immediately after that” or “at once” (also, therefore)
<b>Therewith:</b>	“with that” (also, thereupon; forthwith)
